

Resolution No. 713

WHEREAS, the sixty-third Legislature passed and the President of the Senate signed Senate Joint Memorial 8005 requesting the Transportation Commission to commence proceedings to name state route number 117 in Clallam county between the junction of state route number 101 and Marine Drive in the city of Port Angeles the "POW/MIA Memorial Highway" to honor the service and sacrifice of all prisoners of war, missing in action, and those unaccounted who served for the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission concurs that it is important and appropriate to honor the service and sacrifice of veterans who were prisoners of war, missing in action or otherwise unaccounted for; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington State Transportation Commission does hereby name state route number 117 the "POW/MIA Memorial Highway".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Washington State Transportation Commission requests the Department of Transportation to provide signing reflecting this naming designation accordingly.




