



Motorcycle Registrations by County Washington State, 2005-07



Between 2005 and 2007, nearly half (47.9%) of all Washington motorcycles registrations were in King, Pierce, and Snohomish Counties.



**Motorcycle Operators Involved in Fatal Crash Without a Proper License
by County of Crash
Washington State, 2005-07**



Between 2005 and 2007, one-third of motorcycle operators involved in a fatal crash in Washington were not properly licensed.

In Pierce County, nearly half (48.0%) of all motorcycle operators involved in a fatal crash were not properly licensed compared to 29.8% in King County and 27.6% in Snohomish County.
