Phase 1, Dec 2011-Jun 2012

- Small contract with PSRC 2011
- Initial regional project list from WSTC Top Twenty
- Top 20 plugged into early version
- RTPO ad hoc sub-group formed

Phase 2, Jul 2012 – Jun 2013

- Legis. Budget Proviso
- WCOG Admin/Project Mgt.
- PSRC-led RTPO sub-committee
- Strategy meetings
- Recommendations
- Vetted by all RTPOs





- WSDOT projects provided but not open for display by RTPOs
- RTPOs vary in interest and use
- Forward Washington can be an excellent public information tool

• Next Steps

- No new revenue for 2014
- Pursue funding from State budget for SFY 2015
- Continue working with WSDOT staff to enable RTPO display
- Increase relevance by associating with existing WSDOT “Dashboard”
- Long term funding should be identified for Forward Washington
